

Awareness Programme on Cage culture in Dumbur Reservoir, Tripura

An awareness cum training programme on Cage culture for enhanced fish production from Reservoir was organised at O/o. Spdt. of Fisheries, Gandacherra Subdivision, Dhalai district of Tripura on September 7, 2021. The purpose of organizing such programme was uplifting the fish productivity of the Dumbur Reservoir from current level of just 119 kg/ha/year to 250 kg/ha/year through capacity building of local fishermen bodies on community cage culture. More than thirty fishermen from Dumbur Fishermen Cooperative Society participated in that programme.
